When completed, we'll be adding a third radio connected to a multi-band beam and rotor system up 55 feet!

Our HamClubsOnLine activation has been completed thanks to **Matt AF9Q**'s efforts. This gives us a strong club management tool. By now you should have received some notices. Many functions of our club are now automated.

No need, but you may want to log into <u>HamClubOnline</u> just to see the benefits this brings to the LRA. If you're a member, simply set up your own password.

### **KR9RK Remote HF Station: LRA Project North Star**

<<IMPORTANT>> We will be upgrading the system software to 3.9.18 on Wednesday, June 4. Users must install SmartSDR v 3.9.18 on their PCs after the upgrade. <u>PREVIOUS VERSIONS WILL NO LONGER WORK</u>. If you receive a warning that prompts you to upgrade or downgrade the radios, please do not do so. It means that you are not running the correct version of the software on your PC.

Software is free and may be downloaded <u>HERE</u> (https://www.flexradio.com/software/smartsdr-v3-9-18/)

Users should all be enrolled in the Project North Star <u>groups.io</u> forum. We will make all system announcements there. Search <u>groups.io</u> or contact me at <u>VP@KR9RK.COM</u> for an invite. This forum will be used for system operational announcements only and not for casual conversation.

Station access procedure:

- A setup donation will be required for those who have not already contributed. Please contact Rick at <u>TREASURER@KR9RK.COM</u> for more information.
- Contact Bruce, K9WBT, via email at <u>k9wbt.ham@gmail.com</u> to schedule system training.

The presentation may be viewed here: <u>April 29 North Star Update</u> The committee has already been hard at work and installed our first test station at the Raymond, Wisconsin radio site. It will be modest at first, but the vision is amazing. Also, the remote NC station is already on line.



In the early days on the prairie, farmers used to join up for a "barn raising". On Monday, April 28, **Rick, KC9UJO** assembled a team of "antenna raising" construction volunteers (**Bernie N9AZA**, **Jeff KC9JOB**, **Fred K9SO**, **Craig KD9UQE**, and **Tom KA9KJE**) and they raised our first ever HF antenna. It's a Gap Titan and she's a beauty. Braving wind gusts of up to 50mph, the team repaired the antenna which had previously been badly damaged from the everpresent winds and installed it atop a new Rohn 25g tower section. A new set of Dacron guy lines should prevent future damage:

Use of the KR9RK callsign is restricted. No extended operating privileges are included. Since it's your license, it's your responsibility to stay in band and operate legally. Now's your reason to upgrade!


## **Quarterly Membership Meeting**


My new network NATTING was weak Made my radio setups look bleak With a new NIC in my NUC, I reversed all my luck. Now I'm back in true form as a GEEK.


